7. Include your friends when you are playing. They will feel very happy and include you, too!

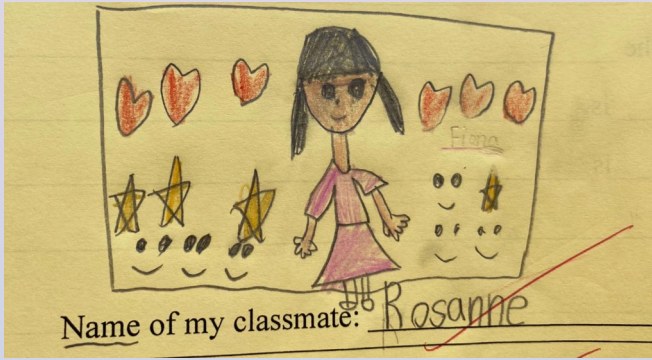
