Habit 2: Begin with the end in mind

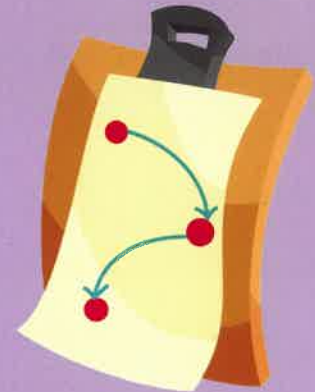
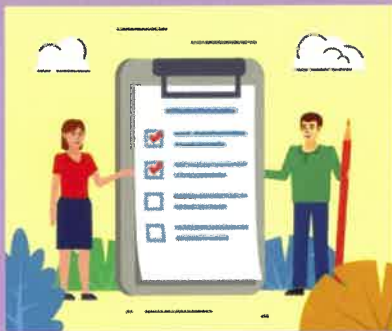
Know what you want to do in the future.

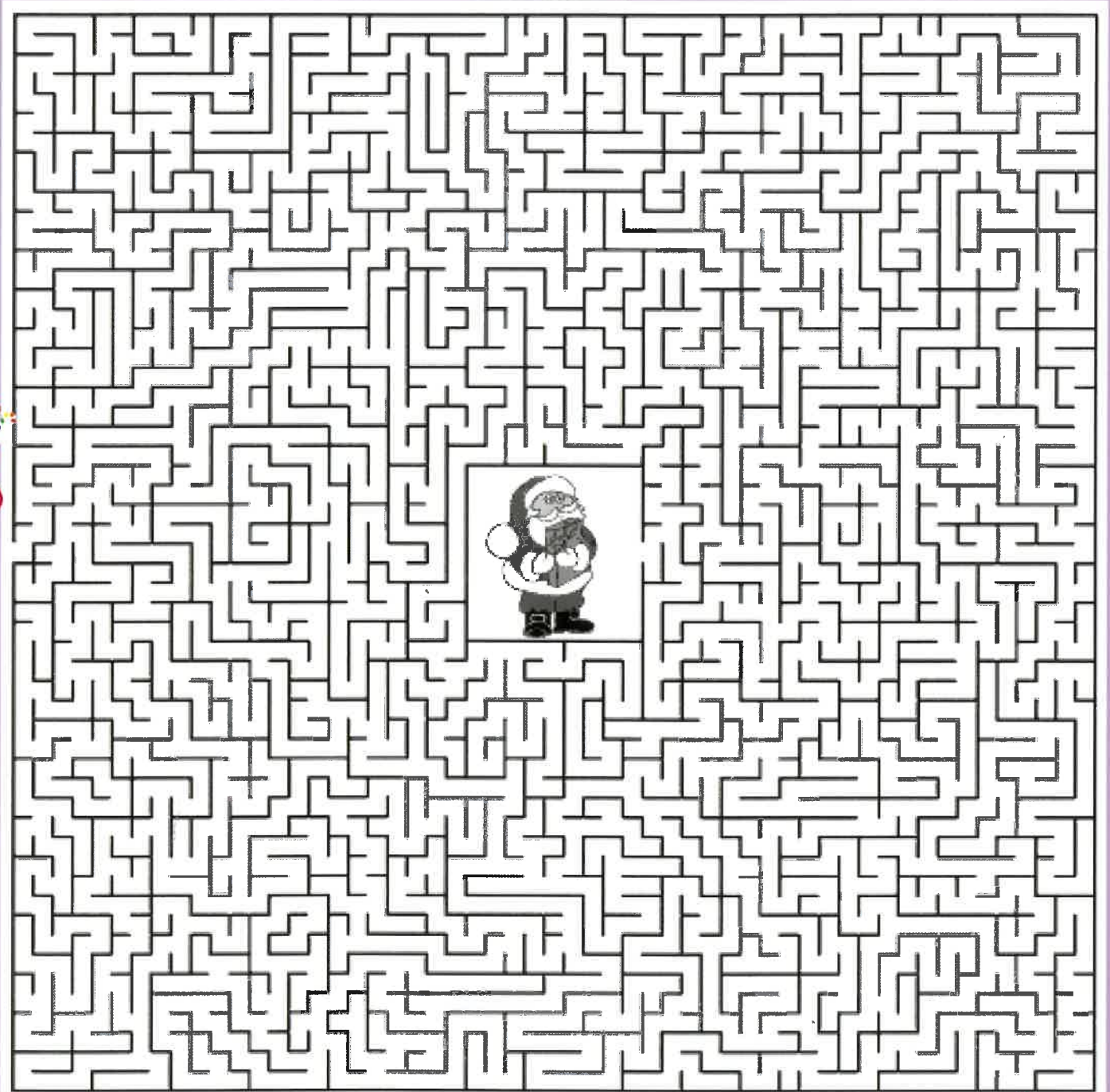

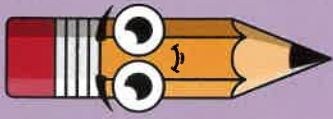
